

UDIA NSW & SMEC Urban Young Developers' Leadership Award 2011

AWARD OVERVIEW

The UDIA NSW & SMEC Urban Young Developers' Leadership Award acknowledges and promotes the positive contribution of young property professionals to the NSW property industry. UDIA NSW encourages young professionals across all disciplines of the development industry from both the public and private sectors to enter including developers, contractors, consultants, those involved in property services, property management, marketing and professional support services.

The Award aims to:

- identify up and coming leaders in the sector;
- recognise the positive influence that young professionals contribute to the industry; and
- acknowledge an outstanding young professional, focusing on the individual's role and level of involvement in the industry.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the UDIA NSW & SMEC Urban Young Developers' Leadership Award, applicants must:

- be 35 years of age or under as of 30 June 2011;
- be based in NSW and be available for an interview in Sydney if required;
- have a minimum of 5 years experience in the development industry or an associated industry (predominately in NSW);
- be nominated by a senior member of their organisation/ third party or self nominated with a commendable third party referee;
- be a member of UDIA NSW (includes company membership); and
- complete requirements as stated on the submission form and return completed form to the UDIA NSW office by Friday 12 August 2011.

* Please note, members of the 2011 UDIA NSW Young Developers' Committee are not eligible to be nominated for this award.

BENEFITS OF THE AWARD

The recipient of the award will be the ambassador for UDIA NSW Young Developers' and act as a link between young property professionals and the industry at large.

The prize package includes:

- the 2011 Young Developers' Leadership Award trophy and certificate;
- a profile in the UDIA NSW Developers Digest magazine;
- complimentary ticket to attend the 2011 UDIA NSW Annual Christmas Lunch;
- Opportunity to join a UDIA NSW Committee in 2012.

Conditions of Entry

All entries will remain the property of UDIA NSW and UDIA NSW reserves the right to identify nominees in promotional activities for the UDIA NSW & SMEC Urban Young Developers' Leadership Award 2011. All submission material remains the property of UDIA NSW. Judges will be appointed based on their expertise. The judges reserve the right to make no award if the standard of entries does not meet the requirements. Additional merit can be awarded at the judges' discretion. The judges' decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

ENTRY PROCESS & DOCUMENTATION

Entrants can be nominated by their organisation/ third party or be self nominated with a third party referee. To enter, the submission form must be completed and returned to the UDIA NSW office with the two additional supporting documents (as outlined below).

- Completed submission form (in word document format including entry details, addressed criteria and payment details. Your response to each criteria should be no more than half a page and no more than four pages in total addressing criteria)
- A reference letter (maximum one A4 page)
- A CV and brief biography (maximum four A4 pages)

Submissions close on Friday 12 August 2011 and are to be submitted via email to events@udia-nsw.com.au with the subject line "Young Developer Leadership Award Submission". Late applications will not be accepted.

A judging panel of industry representatives will assess all submissions based on the criteria and determine a short list of finalists. Finalists will be contacted in August and required to attend an interview with the judging panel in August or September 2011. After the interviews take place, the judges may call the nominating parties and referees before determining the winner.

The 2011 winner will be announced at the UDIA NSW Annual State Conference Dinner on Thursday 13 October 2011 at the Ivy Room, Sydney.

ENTRY FEE

A fee of \$60 per application is to be paid at the time of entry.
